



Home-School Agreement 2012

Eardisley CE primary School is a caring values-based primary school, committed to providing an ethos of traditional values together with a world-class curriculum for all its children. We provide a happy, secure and stimulating environment in which children can develop both intellectually and socially. We encourage an enjoyment of life and a love of learning. We believe that a positive partnership with parents is crucial and will promote our vision of giving children 'roots and wings'.

Our School will:

- Provide your child with a high standard of education, implemented within a nurturing ethos and through a broad, balanced and vibrant curriculum.
- Ensure that our learning environment is stimulating and challenging.
- Encourage a high standard of behaviour, punctuality and attendance.
- Support your child to develop a positive attitude to life and learning through a framework of Christian values.
- Encourage your child to become an active member within our community and help them to see that they can have an impact on the world around them.
- Regularly meet with you to communicate the progress of your child, celebrating their strengths and explaining how we can support them in their areas for development.
- Provide information to you about our school, including relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities, newsletters and open days.
- Set differentiated and achievable homework to extend the curriculum and provide the opportunity for independent learning.
- Celebrate your child's academic and personal achievements.

As a family we will:

- Support and uphold the school's values and ethos.
- Make sure that our child arrives at school on time (not left unsupervised in the playground before 8.45 a.m.) and is collected at 3.15 p.m. by an adult known to the child and school.
- Make sure our child attends school regularly and provides a note of explanation or telephones the school immediately if our child is due to absent on any day.
- Support and work with the school to ensure that the policies for behaviour and homework and school uniform are maintained.
- Attend meetings that are relevant and involve their child.
- Let the school know of any problems concerns or worries that may be affecting my child's learning, behaviour or ability to do homework, as this can then be resolved quickly.

As a Child of Eardisley CE Primary School I will:

- Keep the agreed School Qualities.
- Keep all the agreed class rules.
- Do my best, making every effort to produce classwork and homework of a high standard.
- Be caring, considerate and respectful towards others.

'Together' we will support each child's well-being and learning to help them achieve their best.
