Car Parking Policy

Introduction and Rationale

Eardisley CE Primary School has a duty of care to all its children and must be vigilant about their safety at all times. We know that parents will want to behave responsibly in this matter and will realise their role in helping us keep all our children safe.

The parking availability on the school site is severely restricted for the following practical reasons:

- There is not enough room in the car park for all parents to drop off their children
- Cars being in the same area as children walking through puts children's safety at risk
- The school's insurance arrangements do not cover parents using the car park.
- The school must provide safe parking for school buses and guarantee access for emergency vehicles.

Car Parking Regulations

Please park responsibly in the side road by Orchard Close or on the other side of the main road by the church, or at The Tram.

Parents are requested not to enter the school site car park from 8.00 am to 9.15 am and 2.15 pm to 3.35 pm.

Any parent who feels they have a justification for using the school site car park, for example if they are disabled in any way, please put this in writing for consideration by the School Governors.

The School Governors are working closely with the Local Authority and the Parish Council to improve road safety near the school and to improve parking facilities for the school. We are assured that in due course, further arrangements will be made to vastly increase the parking spaces for our school and we will continue to press for this most strenuously.
