Message from J P Catering – School Lunches after Half Term

Just a reminder that all orders and payments must be handed in to school, or sent via e-mail to julietclark@btinternet.com by **WEDNESDAY MORNING of 23rd May** at the very latest for lunches after half term. No orders can be accepted after this time.

KS1 (years R,1 and 2) receiving Universal Free School meals and those on Benefit Related Free School meals will be put through on previous option choices unless an updated order is received.

Please remember to state method of payment (cash/cheque/BACS) and total

amount being paid on the order form. If payment is to be made by BACS, please write 'BACS payment' with the total and then email Juliet Clark on the above e-mail address to advise when payment is being made. This payment must be received by J P Catering before the week in which the lunches are being taken please.

For children in Beech and Oak classes the amount for the whole half term will be 35 days at £2.30 = £80.50 (Year 6 children £73.60 - taking off Red Ridge). You are, of course, welcome to pay weekly. Please ensure that the school receives the order and payment, in an envelope, by Wednesday of the term week before the meal is required. Thank you.
